

Three's Class Information

Transportation:

If your child plans to go home with someone other than his/her normal ride, you must send in a written note. This will ensure the safety of all the children.

Clothing:

Please send your child to school in comfortable clothing. Please keep in mind that craft time includes washable paints and markers, however, some could leave a stain. Tennis shoes are required for school. We will be going outside, unless it is rainy or extremely cold, so please make sure your child has appropriate clothing for the season. Please label everything! We will also need an extra set of clothing (to include underwear and socks). Please put this in a gallon size zip-loc bag with your child's name on it. We will keep them at school.

Lunch:

Please bring a healthy lunch and drink for your child. We would like the children to gain some self-help skills, so try to send them things that they can easily open. Please remember that we have a lot of children having lunch at the same time so we won't be able to microwave anything.

Birthdays:

Turning four is exciting and we will celebrate birthdays after lunch. If your child wishes, he or she may bring in treats for the class. Please send a note in advance, so we can plan for the special day. Children with allergies must bring in their own baked goods to keep here at the school in the freezer for other children's birthdays.

Discipline:

We have more energy at the age of three than ANY other time in our lives! Keep in mind that this is "Preschool" and we are learning to stand in line, work with others, share, and gain responsibilities. It is going to be a learning process. Our goal is to maintain safety and order so that the children can enjoy their school day. We will use redirection, change of environment, and positive reinforcement to maintain correct behavior. If necessary, we will use the thinking chair. If your child has difficulties during the day, we will inform you with a note or a phone call. If you notice anything that will cause a change of behavior (a late night, no breakfast), please let us know with a note or a phone call. This will help us give your child the extra attention they may need.

Important Information:

Arrival:

Children will be dropped off in the carpool line between 8:55 and 9:10 AM.

Dismissal:

Children should be picked up promptly at 12:30 PM each day. On Mondays and Wednesdays, children will be picked up in the carpool line. On Fridays, parents pick up their children in the classroom. We do not like to discuss children in front of them or other parents, so use this time to visit and see the wonderful things your child has done during the week. We will gladly set up a time for us to talk privately.
